1. Travel from home to the workplace will prioritise those methods that have less of a carbon impact.
2. Virtual engagement in our work should be considered as the norm, unless face to face engagement is a necessity.
3. When travelling to a site that is significantly distant, that overnight stays are prioritised. With those stays being walking distance to the place of work.
4. A criteria that will be used to consider which Associates will be involved, must include distance from the workplace.

Measurement of annual mileage and the flight miles ensures that Impro is able to monitor the reduction of these. In particular, all flight miles will be offset.
